What is fuel poverty?





### Fuel poverty exists wherever:

A. The property is inefficient (i.e. EPC rating D or worse)

### And:

B. The household would be pushed below the official UK poverty line if they heated the property to adequate levels.





Pre-COVID, cold homes were reported to kill approximately 10,000 people in England and Wales each winter.

This is greater than the combination of:

- All annual road traffic deaths
- All annual alcohol-related deaths
- All annual drug-related deaths

Most of the deaths occur in the elderly population, and take the form of cardiovascular/respiratory deaths, which can be made worse by being cold.





Thankfully there are known solutions to this problem:

- 1) Avoiding the most expensive tariffs
- 2) Adopting more energy-efficient behaviour
- 3) Installing energy-efficient products and appliances
- 4) Maximising household income
